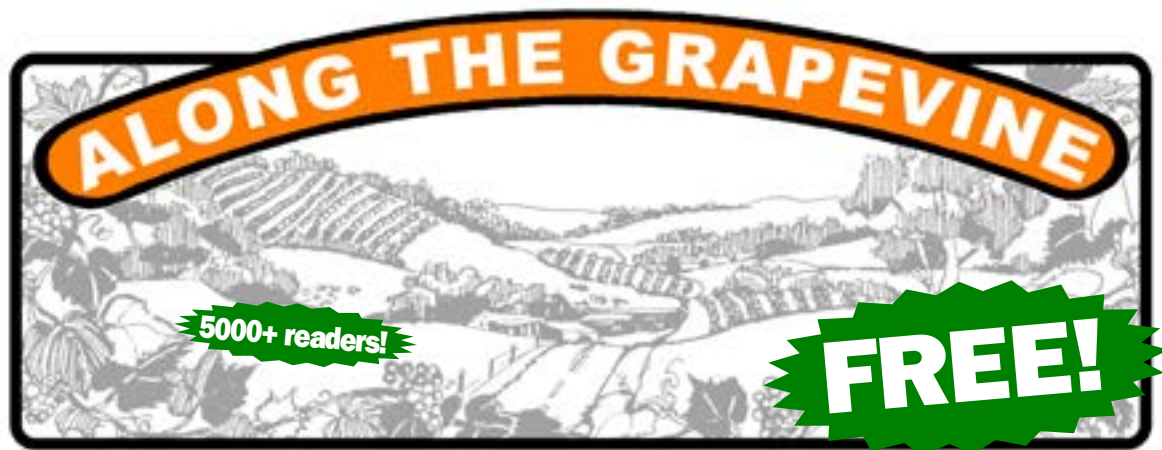

Lenswood and Forest Range Celebrate

Lenswood and Forest Range community members with the Charcoal Burner sculpture on the Lenswood Centennial Park Heritage Trail.

By Kendrea Rhodes - Lenswood and Forest Range is a community rich in life and living; an area so famous for its orchards, vineyards and wineries that you might not notice the thriving history group, well-attended community association, Cold Store Co-operative Society, lively cricket club, sacrosanct bowling green, Fred's Tank, historic primary school, community traditions and dedicated locals. But they're there.

In celebration of this vibrant community, the community association worked with the history group, the school, residents and the Adelaide Hills Council for two years developing the Heritage Trail at Lenswood Centennial Park to commemorate Lenswood's centenary. The Trail highlights the shared history of the area



and starts with Peramangk traditional owners in the main area of the Park. Then over the bridge you can see gold

speculators; settlers going about their work (timber cutters, charcoal burners, pioneer women); horticulturalists; viti-

culturalists; and today's burgeoning tourism industry.

A Christmas Prayer seen on a Christmas Card this year goes like this:

"May knowing Jesus bring you PEACE to bless each day, HOPE for each tomorrow, And JOY in every season"

This is a prayer that can be real and meaningful to us all because Jesus invites us all to come to know Him. We come in faith, not blind faith but rational and reasoned faith that

Jesus is who He claimed to be, and that He alone can redeem and save us through His death at Calvary and Resurrection victory. A rational belief need not be a proven belief, but we believe that the evidence is real that Jesus lived and died and rose from the dead and is alive.

We believe that the Bible is true and is the inspired Word of God. It tells us what

happened in the beginning and what will happen in the future. Why not read it for yourself and see whether it convinces you? But bear in mind that the will is involved in belief as well as the intellect, so be willing to believe when you see good evidence to!

Before His crucifixion Jesus said to His disciples: "... Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy." (John 16:22 NIV).

The Christian writer, Ann Voskamp, sums up her understanding of Christmas: "So God throws open the door of this world—and enters as a baby. As the most vulnerable imaginable. Because He wants unimaginable intimacy with you. What religion ever had

a god that wanted such intimacy with us that He came with such vulnerability to us? What God ever came so tender we could touch Him? So fragile that we could break Him? So vulnerable that His bare, beating heart could be hurt? Only the One who loves you to death."

In Daniel 7:13-14 (NIV) we read: "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven... He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all peoples, nations and men of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed." - And the great news of Christmas is that we all matter to Him.

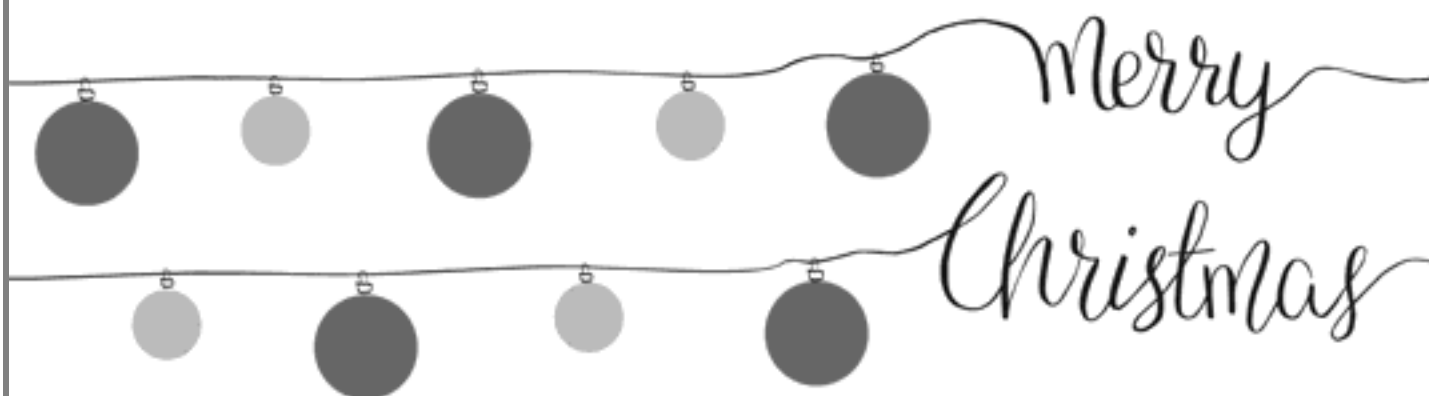

This history is depicted in ten steel sculptured silhouettes dotted throughout the Park on the lush 830m trail, canopied by bird-song and eucalypts. Lenswood Primary School year 6 and 7 students (2017) created artworks as inspiration for the silhouettes, which were modified to meet steel laser cutting and engineering approvals. Each silhouette on the Heritage Trail has a plaque highlighting its historic importance and a QR code link to online information.

The area was once called Forest Range and before that various names including Jerry's Flat. The Lenswood township was not officially called Lenswood until a postal receiving office was opened in

1917. In apt reflection of their beginnings, the two pivotal icons of the town – Lenswood Primary School and Lenswood Post Office – were celebrated together in October, combining the opening of the Heritage Trail with the 150th anniversary of the School. Peramangk/Kaurna elder, Ivan-Tiwu Copely performed a Welcome To Country at the Park and a Smoking Ceremony at the School. Special guests, Adelaide Hills Mayor, Jan-Claire Wisdom and the Minister for Education, Mr John Gardner, also attended the celebrations.

The Heritage Trail silhouettes and historic plaques were sponsored by a broad cross section of the community including the Lions

Club of Onkaparinga, Lenswood Primary School, Lenswood and Forest Range History Group, Forest Range Recreation Ground, anonymous donors and families: Coulter, Mason, Vickers, Schultz, Shaw, Peterson and Murdoch. The Adelaide Hills Council and Federal Government supported the project through grants, approvals and accessibility.

Centenary celebrations for Mount Barker District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital

Celebrations to mark the centenary of the Mount Barker District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital were held at the hospital on Friday, 29 November 2019.

The celebrations included a presentation on the early history of the Hospital from Bob Dewell OAM and Ian Smith, an acknowledgement of past, present and future returned services members by Cate Goodall and a prayer by Margaret Westphal.

Dan Cregan MP, Member for Kavel representing the Minister for Health and Wellbeing said that it was a

great honour to be a part of the celebrations.

"The celebrations were a reminder of the proud history of the hospital which has provided care to our community for 100 years," Mr Cregan said.

"I am pleased that the new State Government has been able to significantly invest in local healthcare during our first twenty months."

"The State Government has funded a Dialysis Unit at the Hospital, appointed Russell & Yelland Architects to design a masterplan for the site, secured Commonwealth

funds for an Emergency Department upgrade, boosted country chemo services and put more funds into paediatrics. We have also entered into an ongoing contract for 24 hour doctor services."

The Minister for Health and Wellbeing, the Hon Stephen Wade MLC thanked the Morrison Federal Government for their commitments of \$8.6 million to upgrade the Mount Barker District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital and \$8.4 million to upgrade the South Coast Districts Hospital.

"With the assistance of

local members Dan Cregan, Josh Teague and David Basham I have approached the office of Federal Health Minister Greg Hunt urging the Commonwealth to release the funding earlier than planned so we can get the ball rolling on these important projects. I have also discussed the need to bring this funding forward with Rebekha Sharkie - the Member for Mayo," Minister Wade said.

"Improved emergency services at the Hospital has seen significant growth in presentations and as the area's population continues to increase so will presentations."

"The people of the Mount Barker and the South Coast deserve the best health care and the Marshall and Morrison governments are determined to give them just that," Minister Wade added.

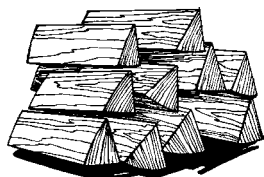
