

This is actual sharing: no obligation, no bartering and The money. only valuation is increased social capital within the community from a system based on cooperation trust, and understanding essential elements for a well-adjusted society.

The Basket Range Sharing Shed combines two altruistic ideas: Grow Free and Street Library. On its shelves you will find home grown produce such as fruit, vegetaherbs, serves, eggs, seeds including Heirloom,

seedlings, cuttings and rootstock. Also, other items like cofgrounds worm tea for the garden, gardening magazines, clean jars, preserves, paper bags and boxes too. While you're there, browse the Street Library for novels, children's magazines books, and read the pinboard for notes and heartfelt messages of gratitude.

The Grow Free concept began in Strathalbyn, but the ideas of sharing food and surplus have long existed between groups of humans.

Grow Free is a modern format for an ancient practice; a format that fits into our fast-paced lives of technology, transport and efficiency. started with sharing seedlings and promoting more nutritious foods, but has blossomed into sharing surplus produce like eggs, fruit and veg, and gardening implements. The Grow Free concept has expanded into Western Australia, New South Wales, Victoria, New Zealand and the USA. In the Adelaide Hills there are more than 20

Grow Free Carts including another combined with a Street Library at The Olive Branch Café in Balhannah. Visit the 'Grow Free - Adelaide Hills' Facebook group to keep up with the latest or website more information: www.growfree.com. au.

The Street Library is a similar concept based on sharing and surplus without money or barter. There's no library card or ID required, just respect and literary love. The idea is simple: browse the Street Library, take a

book and go about your day. And if you have books gathering dust, you might feed them back into a Street Library sometime in the future. For more information visit their website: streetlibrary.org.au.

## **Dunn Memorial Church** receives heritage grant

The State Government has provided a grant of \$12,470 towards heritage preservation work at the Memorial Dunn Church in Mount Barker.

The funds will be put towards urgent work to repair the spire and tower of the Church. Small sections of the spire and facade of the building have broken off, posing a safety risk to pedestrians.

The Church was one of 25 State Heritage listed places in South Australia to receive a grant through the second

round of the SA Heritage Grants program.

Dan Cregan MP, Member for Kavel said that the State Government committed to helping rejuvenate South Australia's built heritage.

"The spire and tower of the Church have needed repair work for quite some time," Mr Cregan said.

"I am pleased that State Government has been able to provide a contribution towards the repairs."

Mrs Margaret Rose, Chairperson of the Dunn Memorial

Church said the repair work would ensure the building was preserved for future generations.

"The Dunn Memorial Church is one of the most significant historical buildings in Mount Barker," Mrs Rose said.

"This grant is in addition to a previous grant of \$7,530 that the Church received through round one of SA Heritage the Grant Program."

"We very much appreciate Dan's support in securing the funds towards the urgent work now underway."


