



The market wouldn't be possible without founder, Elizabeth Barber,


who has designed the market to be a family-friendly atmosphere, inviting people to experience Gumeracha and everything it has to offer.

Council approves first Solar Farm in the Adelaide Hills

At a recent meeting, Adelaide Hills Council's Assessment Panel (CAP) approved a 4.9MW Solar Farm which will cover thirteen hectares of the 51 hectare site.

This is the first farm of its kind in the Adelaide Hills and is planned to be built at the intersection of Warren and Torrens Valley Roads, Birdwood. The application was publicly notified and in response 80 people provided feedback on the application. Ten of these respondents presented to the Panel on behalf of eighteen people. The majority of the respondents are local residents.

CAP's decision was unanimous in support of

the proposal and members of the Panel articulated their reasons for doing so at the meeting, and acknowledged the value of hearing the representations provided.

"The Panel stated that it was good to hear from the local residents who they appreciated may not agree with the outcome. However, the value of people raising their concerns should not be underestimated as it resulted in the proposal being modified by Tetris Energy to address the concerns raised," said Marc Salver, Director Development & Regulatory Services.

As a result of the submissions received, Tetris

Energy (the applicant) amended its proposal to reduce the height of the ground mounted solar arrays from 4.65m to 2.9m, increased the amount of landscaping along the boundary of the property and provided a 100m buffer along Torrens Valley Road. These changes were made to address the visual impact concerns raised by residents.

As a non-complying application, the representors have appeal rights against the Panel's decision, and should they wish to, they can lodge the appeal with the Environment, Resources and Development Court. The Independent Presiding Member of the

Panel made members of the gallery aware of this option.

"In circumstances such as this where there is a large amount of concern expressed about a development proposal, it should be acknowledged that the Panel assesses an application on its merits when considering the legislative requirements and Council's Development Plan principles," said Mr Salver.

If the proposal goes ahead, Council will ensure that the development is constructed in accordance with the approved plans, including the planting of the landscaping to ensure that the visual impacts are mitigated.

'Revealed' - SECRETS FROM THE MEN'S SHED

Following on from their highly successful SALA exhibition which culminated on the October long weekend, Top of The Torrens Gallery at Birdwood have now unveiled a fresh new exhibition featuring the works of 14 talented artists and artisans who spend much of their creative time 'in the shed'.

Fabulously diverse in its offering, works include pencil drawings by Alice Shore & Seth Mancini, who also has two vibrant digitally enhanced portraits on display. Metal sculptures in the wonderful wide ranging styles of Adrian Beacham, Steve Hausler, Leon Holmes & Nathan Modra, are a joy to behold along with mixed media and ceramic sculptures by Jacky Charleston.

In addition to her earthy

ceramic tablewares, Joe Dennis has wall art on display and the bright signature style of Mike Painter's acrylic paintings on canvas also adorn the gallery walls.

A beautiful collection of petite paintings of ships under sail by Charles Mace is complimented by his trio of incredible hand-crafted models of ships in bottles. "I hadn't built a ship model in some years until the advent of the COVID-19 epidemic and the temporary closing of the Salisbury Art Society, so with art on the back burner I returned to the hobby even to the extent of buying a Dremel tool to facilitate my modelling" Charles said. He went on to say "I became so engrossed in my rediscovered hobby that I had to make a conscious effort to start painting again,

however as can be seen from my entries in this exhibition I have now combined both".

Talented local glass artist Ann Beacham uses a number of processes including 'fusing' and 'slumping' to produce her fragile creations. "The fusing process involves a lot of forward thinking to get the right results as the glass shape changes as it is heated. These pieces can be 2 or 3 dimensional, sometimes requiring multiple firings to get the blend and shape required" Ann said.

The versatility of timber as a raw material is abundantly clear when appreciating the highly tactile creations by Alison Dennis, Barry Liddicoat and John Ragless, with exhibited works including a rocking horse, rocking chair and red-gum wall clock with a skele-



ton movement, as well as quirky wall plaques and a beautiful collection of bowls, platters and serving ware.

The exhibition is on view now and concludes on 29th November at Top of the Torrens Gallery & Gift Shop, 9 Shannon Street Birdwood - OPEN 11am to 4pm Wednesday to Sunday.

The picket fence and a profusion of roses clambering up and over an arbour at the front gate at Chez Nous add charm and complement the old stone home, which was built in the late 1800's. The half-acre garden is loosely divided into rooms that blend cottage and formal style with a touch of French ambiance.

In spring, this pretty, fragrant garden is full of colour, the trees underplanted with roses, bright annuals, perennials, and bulbs, with clipped hedges and topiary adding some formality. The mood changes in the fenced productive area with its cute potting/propagating shed, raised veggie beds and hidden compost bins surrounded by fruit and citrus trees. Iris and other flowering plants attract bees and give structure and appeal to the area.

A big shady tree, lawn and outdoor table look very inviting, but continue up the garden path to where the pond and its dense eco-friendly, water efficient plantings provide a home to ducks, chooks, frogs, bees and butterflies. Peonies, self-sown old-fashioned favourites like foxgloves, peony poppies, delphiniums and an incredibly old heritage apple tree thrive. Nearby is an area of Australian natives.

The garden is maintained using organic and environmentally sustainable gardening practices. Low stone walls are used to define garden beds. Throughout Chez Nous clever vintage installations for climbing plants and artistic touches show the owner's flair and passion for eclectic pieces.



Chez Nous recently featured in *Australian Country* - gracing the cover of this glossy, national magazine. It's a very pretty garden that is sure to delight visitors!

Moving A Head awarded Australia Post Community Grant

Moving A Head has been awarded a grant of \$3,000 as part of Australia Post's 2020 Community Grants Program for its work in Mt Barker, South Australia.




