



WHY SHOULD I GO TO CHURCH? This is a slightly different, but perhaps more important question. The SA Government have an advert running on the TV warning about the dangers of complacency regarding the risk of spreading Covid-19.

I sense complacency is also a great problem amongst God's people, after all, the church will still be there next week or next month, I can go then.

Christians have been meeting together weekly from the very beginning of the Church, to break bread and to be reminded of what Jesus has done for them. Acts 20:7a - Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread.

And the writer of Hebrews, directed by the Holy Spirit, instructs us to continue to meet to build one another up and encourage each other, particularly in these last days.

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, ²⁵not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

In places like Russia, China, and North Korea, Christians gather each week with the risk of imprisonment or death an everpresent reality, because they love the Lord Jesus and want to worship and honour Him, whatever the danger.

God is pleased when His children meet, and as we gather, we are a powerful witness to those around us that our faith is real.

Strength to strength at Mt Pleasant Farmers Market

The Mt Pleasant Farmers Market has gone from strength to strength in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic. With South Australia and the rest of the country coming out of Covid-19 restrictions the Market has had a surge in patron numbers and new membership sign ups.

Assistant Manager Terese Stephens said, "One of the outcomes of the Covid-19 pandemic seems to be that people are thinking about food security and origins. The increase in market patrons has also had a positive consequence for many of our stall holders including our Murray Bridge market gardener, Sabri Dogan, whose business has increased considerably since the end of March. Market stall holder numbers remain at consistent levels with many enquiries being fielded for new stall holder places."

"The challenge now

remains for the market to operate within the Covid-19 regulations. Over the past three months, the market has adapted well to ever changing Covid-19 environment, with many innovations being made to accommodate those regulations. Habitat Recovery Alliance (HRA) collaborates with Gumeracha **Community Mens Shed**

Whilst most people have been home in isolation during Covid-19, unable to do their normal activities, one special man from the Gumeracha Community Mens Shed was very busy! Mr Glyne Smalldon has worked tirelessly to build over 30 nest boxes as part of the Habitat Recovery Alliance's bushfire recovery project. His efforts will assist wildlife recovery on properties affected by the Cudlee Creek fires which destroyed over 21000 Ha of habitat.

HRA Project Coordinator, Kim Thompson said, "Having community members like the Gumeracha Men's Shed involved has been integral to the success of our project. Right from the beginning, we have been overwhelmed with volunteer support and thanks to these guys, these nest boxes can provide artificial habitat for wildlife reliant on hollows. Whilst we recognise they are not a true substitute,, they can make a difference to some species and with the devastation we have seen this summer, we're keen to get them in our landscape before Spring."

Kim said, "Funds from the Landcare Aus-





tralia Bushfire Recovery Grant and the Lockheed Martin Landcare Grant will enable the Habitat Recovery Alliance to deliver essential habitat restoration across the fire scar, including the building and installation of appropriate wildlife nest boxes for each site."

The Community Shed Co-Mens ordinator. Mr Garv Brock is keen to involve the team now that restrictions have lifted and will be facilitating the building of many more. They will focus on specific nest boxes for kookaburras, owls and

nightjars as well as microbats. "Now we have the specifications for each species, we will get the group busy. Everyone loves to feel like they are contributing to something so worth-while, so if anyone is interested in helping, we meet every Tuesday and Thursday from 9am to 12pm, behind the Torrens Valley Community Centre in Gumeracha,' said Gary.


