## **Kenton Creek gets vegetation boost**

On Friday, July 31st, R-7 students, staff and parents from the Gumeracha Primary School worked alongside the Biodiversity Team from the Adelaide Hills Council to plant over 950 native shrubs/trees along the banks of Kenton Creek at Federation Park, adding valuable understorey to the magnificent gum trees that have stood for over 200 years.

This coincided with National Tree Day for schools and was followed by a community planting session in the park on Sunday, August 3rd.

The plants were sourced from Kersbrook Landcare and specifically chosen as they are native to the



area and will ensure that the creek flow is protected for years to come.

The Torrens Valley Lions Club supported by cooking a BBQ lunch for everyone.

The students worked quickly to plant and then waterin the tube stocks and enjoyed playing in the glorious sunshine while the BBQ was cooking.

With our limited imaginations I doubt that any one of us can really grasp just how powerful our God really is.

While this may be true, the Scriptures often encourage us to 'consider,' to take the time to let our minds mull over, just how absolutely wonderful the God we worship is.

We are introduced to the power of God in

the very first verse of our Bible. In Genesis 1:1, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Then in verse 16 the writer simply says, as if it is no big deal, "He made the stars also."

Perhaps David had these Scriptures in mind as he pondered the awesome power of the God that he knew and worshipped.

Psalm 8 (A Psalm

of David) - <sup>3</sup> When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon, and the stars, which You have set in place, <sup>4</sup> What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?

## PREVENTION TIME IS NOV

In this weather it is so tempting to stay indoors, but right now is the time to get outside and do some fire prevention before summer. There may be fallen branches, pine needles, old bushes, or dry debris around your house that could easily fit into your fortnightly green bin. Just imagine how much you will appreciate your warm house and a hot drink when the job is done!

Homes and properties differ in the amount of clean up they can do or need to do. The green organics bins are great for smaller loads and with about 60% of Adelaide Hills residents having a kerbside green bin collection, continuous garden maintenance throughout the year is possible. You're not only doing this for your garden, but for your safety, the safety of your neighbours, and your commu-



nity too.

Matthew Ahern, Team Leader Regulatory Services, Adelaide Hills Council said, "Preparation of your home and property is essential throughout the year to ensure ... [survival during the] fire danger season. A wellprepared home is more likely to survive a bushfire than one that has been neglected."

Fire prevention, particularly protection against airborne embers, includes gutter and roof maintenance around buildings. Mr Ahern provided some simple maintenance

advice such as fixing gaps in your gutters with steel mesh, repairing roof tiles, clearing gutters regularly, and installing ember and gutter guards if desired.

Amongst the stars is the Southern Cross with the two pointers nearby, all of which is seen much clearer away from any city lights.



Adelaide Hills Council has successfully bid for a variety of grants amounting to over \$1 million that will go towards bushfire recovery initiatives and building resilience for the local economy.

Through the Federal Government's Local Road and Community Infrastructure Program we will receive \$781,415 to support jobs, businesses and economic resilience. Proposed projects for these funds include toilet refurbishment and a formed path for the Mill Road Corner pocket forest in Lobethal, a new toilet at the Woodside Institute, building upgrades at Fabrik Arts + Heritage, footpath upgrades, and the completion of a Crafers to Stirling cycle connection.

The donation-based Wildlife Recovery Fund has committed \$50,000 for our use over three years on post-fire weed control for the Lobethal Bushland Park Bushfire Recovery Project. These vital funds will help us achieve significant success in the recovery of this important conser-

vation area.

Finally, Council will receive \$170,000 through the Regional Tourism Bushfire Recovery Grants Program for four different initiatives:

Pome Fest 2020 will receive \$30,000 to produce a virtual, COVID-19 version of its popular event supporting the Apple and Pear Growers SA. Virtual experiences will include orchard and packhouse tours, cider tasting masterclasses, pruning, grafting and cooking demonstrations, and an apple pie cooking competition.

The trail network in Lobethal Bushland Park will be replaced and improved. Proposed infrastructure for the \$40,000 received includes boardwalks, park benches, bollards, trail markers, bridges, hand rails, and informative signage.

A further \$60,000 will go towards the Amy Gillett Bikeway for interpretive signs that will share, educate, and promote local destinations and characteristics to users, as well as including an acknowledgement of who Amy Gillett was.

The remaining \$40,000 will fund a light installation, Flocking Together, created by Cindi Drennan and Illuminart in collaboration with the local community. Illuminart, who are nationally renowned for their spectacular projection works, will create a visual welcome to Lobethal positioned

in Mill Square opposite the township's major intersection. Contributions for the final piece will be sought from the community with support from Fabrik Arts + Heritage.





## Wine growers benefit from balance with nature



A Balhannah winery is taking a walk on the wild side with the aim of reducing insecticide use and improving vine performance.

The winery is one of eight wine and grape growers joining with the Hills and Fleurieu Landscape Board to promote biodiversity in and around vineyards in the Adelaide Hills.

James Hall who is Central Hills Project Coordinator with the Hills and Fleurieu Landscape Board said the board is supporting and collaborating with growers to create a greater balance between the environment and the practice of viticulture, through the Wildlife for Wine project.

In one project, staff from the board are working with Shaw and Smith at their Balhannah property to restore a large wetland area, to plant native understory species on a woodland slope, and to seed a nearby paddock to native grass and forb species

Shaw and Smith viticulturist Murray Leake said the vineyards were in transition to organic certification and required expert advice on managing and enhancing the property's biodiversity.

"The collaboration with staff from the Hills and Fleurieu Landscape Board has enabled us to achieve much more than we would have been able to do without that assistance," he said.

Shaw and Smith and board staff (some pictured above) worked together for several days to plant over 2000 seedlings of native shrubs, sedges, rushes and grasses - following a planting design developed by Hills and

Fleurieu Landscape Board Landscape Officer Rob Murphy - and have now completed the watercourse restoration and woodland plantings.

Mr Hall said, "it has been great working closely with growers who have embraced the project wholeheartedly understanding the environmental and vineyard benefits, plus wanting to bring more balance to the unique viticultural landscapes of the Adelaide Hills."

## PREVENTION TIME IS NOW



Safe 'burning-off' is also an option (where permitted) and all Adelaide Hills Council residents are required to apply for a permit. These are available on their website, free of cost, and are promptly attended to. If you have questions about this, please call the Council's Fire Prevention Officers on 8408 0400. And if you already have a burn permit, you must follow the CFS Codes of Practice to commence burning.

Adelaide Hills Council residents can also attend free. green organic drop off days with a trailer load of clean residential green organics. There are no limits to how many trips residents can make, but you are advised to plan your journey because queues occur sometimes.

Green organics can be dropped off at Gumeracha, Woodside and Heathfield on these dates: 12 & 23 September, 11 & 28 October, 14 & 15 November, and 2 & 5 December. Acceptable green residential organics are prunings, leaves, small branches, and burned vegetation, in a 7x5ft trailer, with proof of residency.




