

Feral rabbits to be tackled through pindone Distribution Days

Landholders will have help to control feral rabbits on their Hills properties through a number of Pindone Distribution Days in February.

Initiated by the Hills and Fleurieu Landscape Board, the Distribution Days will make pindone-treated carrots available for purchase at Woodside and Mount Barker, and staff will be on hand to explain how to do the baiting.

Event coordinator and Hills and Fleurieu Landscape Officer Will Hannaford said rabbits are in concerning numbers at present, particularly around Woodside, Oakbank, Blakiston, Aldgate, Highland Valley and Din-

gabledinga.

“Right now during the height of summer is an ideal opportunity to control rabbits, as they will be attracted to the moisture in the pindone carrots,” he said.

“We have had numerous reports of feral rabbits, and they appear to be mainly impacting home gardens and undermining sheds.”

“Over the last few years, rabbit numbers have been building up. With the excellent conditions last spring, we now have rabbit numbers as high as they have been in many years.

“Baiting will be even more effective if neighbours can coordinate

their efforts and bait at the same time, so consider asking your neighbours to get involved. By following the correct procedure, using pindone can reduce rabbit numbers dramatically.”

Recent releases of the latest strain of calicivirus have had some effect, however, in many locations additional steps like pindone baiting would be needed to have a significant impact on rabbit numbers.

Tulin moved from Turkey to the Adelaide Hills when she married an Australian. She soon started mending, altering, and designing clothes for friends, which eventually blossomed into the business you see today.

Services offered by Adelaide Hills Alterations include dress-making, clothing alterations and tailoring, bridal wear, formal wear, curtains, cushions, laundry and ironing service, spot cleaning (wedding and formal), and the simple, but important everyday things like hems, school uniforms, and

zips. Recent examples of unusual items they've worked on include caravan cushions and curtains, shoes, motorbike seats, and undergarments.

Tulin is a busy person with many ideas. To help realise her plans, she has employed a seamstress, Adelaide Hills local, Shannon Hopton.

"I needed someone to help me. I have so many ideas and they just sit still if I don't have help," she said.

marker of success for the business.

BIOCHAR FOR BEGINNERS

What is Biochar? Biochar is a stable form of charcoal produced using high temperature and little air. So instead of burning fallen timber or orchard prunings in the paddock, you can turn it into a reusable soil fertiliser. At the same time you are reducing greenhouse gasses and capturing carbon, therefore helping to fight against climate change.

Biochar differs from charcoal and lasts in the soil for long periods. It provides many benefits to the soil, for example reducing water use, can be used for agriculture application, commercial landscaping and home gardening.

The Hills Environment Centre has invited members of the maccy biochar community group to present two workshops all about Biochar.

Biochar for Beginners will cover numerous topics including what is biochar, the terminology, the types of biochar,

carbon credits, production methods and application.

The two sessions will be held at the Hills Environment Centre, 4 Crescent Drive, Norton Summit on Saturday, February 20th from 10 am - 3pm. The cost is \$10.00 per person. BYO lunch. Registration is essential. To book email events@hecinc.org.au.

"We hope that property owners will be encouraged to have their own kilns or preferably to form biochar groups in their community, so that fuel loads can be reduced in a way that doesn't increase greenhouse gasses", said Val Hunt Coordinator of HEC. "Converting this waste into a valuable resource is beneficial to the soil and environment. We plan to follow this with a workshop on how to set up a community biochar group, with expertise and advice from the successful maccy biochar group".






