

"We do have tendency, now in biology especially to make up stories, to make theoretical biology a kind of game, in fact we have game theory in biology which is meant to use the theory of games to make predictions or explain things." ~ Richard Lewontin

"We take the side of science in spite of the patent absurdity of some of its constructs, in spite of its failure to fulfill many of its

extravagant promises of health and life, in spite of the tolerance of the scientific community for unsubstantiated just-so stories, because we have a prior commitment, a commitment to materialism... We cannot allow a Divine Foot in the door." ~ Richard Lewontin

Read the quotes again and decide for yourself if evolution, (the belief that everything made itself.) comes under the definition of a religion. Thankfully an increasing number of highly credentialed scientists are coming to the realization that the complexities of life make evolution an impossibility.

WHY DOES ANY OF THIS MATTER?

Our message to you over the time we have been writing these editorials has consistently been that you, personally, matter to the God of the Bible. God loves you and He invites you to become a part of His family. He has provided the way for vou to come through lesus Christ.
