erans are walking 1200km along the Heysen Trail in South Australia to raise money for veteran charity, Soldier On. The two walkers, 64year-old Ross Boyd (pictured right), and 65-year-old Ian Errington (pictured middle), are walking from the Flinders Ranges through the winegrowing valleys to the Fleurieu Peninsula, a distance of about 1,200 kilometres. They have a support crew of one, 76-yearold Tony Turner (pictured left), a Vietnam veteran.

"The scenery is amazing, and the people are beautiful," says Ian of the trek so far. At time of writing, the team was heading into Kapunda, having trekked over 400km so far.

"The weather is challenging sometimes, with horizontal rain and the cold snap" says Ross. "And some bloody big hills," adds Ian. But all three agree it's a truly beautiful part



of the world and the people they've met are very friendly and welcoming. "It's just been incredible. We've met locals and other hikers and everyone has been so kind."

It is generally thought that the Old Testament prophet, Jeremiah, wrote the book of Lamentations, and although he wrote of the suffering that the people of Jerusalem were undergoing as a result of the Babylonian invasion of 586BC, he also wrote of God's love and compassion (Lam 3:22): "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." Jeremiah deeply lamented what happened to the people of Jerusalem, but he trusted in God and was able to state: "For men are not cast off by the Lord forever. Though he brings grief, he will show compassion, so great is his unfailing love." (Lam 3:31-32).

And in Psalm 30:4-5, King David's words are recorded: "Sing to the Lord, you saints of his; praise his holy name. For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favour lasts a lifetime; weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning."

Aaron Berry, on crosswalk. com, comments: "There isn't a human being alive on this planet who isn't acquainted with troubles. Times of difficulty arrive unexpectedly, often remain indefinitely, and the sorrowful memories they produce take deep root in the mind. It is no wonder, then, why Jesus's promise in John 16:33 also takes deep root in the minds and hearts of so many Christians: 'In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.'... Following Christ is difficult and there will be opposition. Yet, the reality of Christ's victory over sin and death via his own death and resurrection provides peace and courage in the midst of that opposition.

And Mike Riccardi in blog, tms.edu states: "The world today wants nothing to do with sorrow. It drowns out its sorrow with busyness, music, therapists, and even medication... But sorrow can be beneficial; it is not always a bad thing... There is a sorrow that God wants you to experience, because the sorrow that is according to the will of God 'produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation' (2 Cor

7:10) ... repentance begins with an intellectual recognition and confession of sin. but it does not end there. There is also a "change of heart"-an emotional component in which the genuine believer mourns over having sinned against the God whom he loves. That is why in the classic psalm of repentance, Psalm 51, David says, "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise."

Troubles may be considered valuable if they bring us recognition of our own need for repentance and forgiveness. Let us remember that: *"weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning."* We believe we all matter to God.
