

In the New Testament book of Acts, chapter 17, verses 24 to 28a, it is recorded that the apostle Paul addressed the people of Athens to proclaim to them:

May he teach us to be supple and thirsty for the everyday wonders of being alive - so that our minds don't grow weary."

The following Hebrew Proverb sums it up simply and clearly: 'Those who seek more than they need hinder themselves from enjoying what they have.'

The Old Testament book of Deuteronomy, chapter 4:39 states: "Acknowledge and take to heart this day that the Lord is God in heaven above and on the earth below. There is no other."

As Christians, we believe that through Jesus' death and resurrection we are offered the gift of eternal life. 
"We love to get our community involved in creating and installing our decorations and showing them what can be done when you recycle, recreate and repurpose items," said Barbara.

March is truly an amazing time to be in the Adelaide Hills! The weather is beautiful and the leaves are slowly changing, giving way to cooler evenings and shorter days. We are truly blessed to have many orchards, farms and gardens bursting with fresh produce. One of my favour-

ite and most versatile fruits are in season right now...apples!

Apples are so versatile, they can be used in sweet and savoury dishes, used as a sugar substitute and enjoyed fresh or cooked.

This recipe is delicious hot or cold, but is always best served with double thick cream!

Caramel Upside **Down Cake**

Granny Smith apples, peeled, cored and sliced

115 grams butter

1 cup brown sugar, packed

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Melt butter in a large frypan over a medium heat, add the brown sugar and mix with a wooden spoon until the two have mixed together.

Add the apple and cinnamon, stir for around 10 minutes.

Pour the caramelised apples into a greased casserole dish.

In a small mixing bowl, mix together 1 cup plain flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder and 1/2 teaspoon salt.

In a large mixing bowl whisk 3/4 cup white sugar, 3/4 cup

packed brown sugar, 1/2 cup sour cream, 2 large eggs, 6 tablespoons softened butter and 1 teaspoon vanilla.

Add dry ingredients to the wet and mix until combined.

Cover apples with batter, covering all apples and bake at 180 degrees for 40 minutes.

Let sit in dish for half an hour before placing a larger plate over casserole dish and flip so the apples are on top.

Serve with a generous dollop of double cream and enjoy!



Cregan calls for Government to fund a Doctor at Gumeracha Hospital ED

Dan Cregan MP, Member for Kavel, has called on the State Government to commit funding for an afterhours doctor service at the Gumeracha District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital Emergency Department.

"The Gumeracha ED has been supported by local doctors for many years but they require additional funding to continue to provide any emergency service at all. Things are so bad that the ED is now closed with no known plans for it to re-open." Mr Cregan said.

In late January, the Gumeracha Medical Practice, which has supported the Gumeracha ED, said their pleas for more help had been ignored.

"We have spent years pleading with the health bureaucracy at all levels for assistance but have had no success..." the Practice said.

"If you have concerns about the lack of Government support for your health service then please let our health bureaucrats and the politicians know. With an election coming up

they might actually pay attention to what the community want."

Mr Cregan said health professionals requests for more assistance to provide the vital local ED service had been ignored because Kavel and Morialta were safe Liberal seats.

"I believe both major parties have ignored this service and let it close because there has been no political reason to keep it open. Our Hills community deserves much better."

"Residents Lobethal, Forest Range, Lenswood and Charleston, and other towns, have to travel long distances to the nearest hospital in Mt Barker or the City. It is also putting pressure on local ambulances," Mr Cregan added.

Mr Cregan is making a night doctor service at the Gumeracha ED one of his 10 key election issues if he is called on to form government after the State Election.

"My community deserves basic front-line emergency healthcare. I've had a real gutful of bureaucrats making

excuses about why we can't have that support," Mr Cregan said.

A petition started by Mr Cregan calling on

the State Government to re-open the Gumeracha ED has attracted more than 2,500 signa-


