

Returning to its original one-day format in 2022, around 3,500 garden lovers made the picturesque journey to Mount Pleasant in the Barossa Valley on Saturday, where the festival ran in conjunction with the weekly Mount Pleasant Farmers Market.

Communications Officer for the market, Nicki Nolan, said the festival was a wonderful day.

"In addition to our regular 30 farmers market stalls, with the freshest produce in the region, we had a fabulous variety of around 50 plant, garden and homewares stalls", she said. "Our vendors had a great day and they're already excited

Looking out for Bandicoots

Southern Brown Bandicoots are classified as Endangered in the Mt Lofty Ranges, but the **Bandicoot Superhighway Project** (BSH) aims to reduce the risk of their extinction.

Sturt Upper Reaches Landcare Group (SURLG) President, Danny Rohrlach, will talk about this innovative and ambitious project that brings together community, philanthropy and government in a unique partnership.

The Bandicoot Superhighway is a community led initiative, with SURLG partnering with the Hills & Fleurieu Landscape



Board, The Nature Conservation Society of SA, The Foundation for National Parks and Wildlife, The Commonwealth Government, and the University of Adelaide.

It has a long-term vision to foster improved and betterconnected habitat throughout the southern Mt Lofty Ranges and includes a range of actions such as weed control and revegetation, translocation, citizen science and various public awareness and engagement activities.

Our Central Hills are a hotspot for bandicoots in SA and in protecting these endangered marsupials the project also aims to benefit the wider biodiversity, e.g. other small mammals and our increasingly threatened small birds.

Beginning in areas geographically close to SURLG the project aims to increase in scope over time to include activity over the whole area historically occupied by bandicoots, ranging from near Kersbrook in the north down to Deep Creek. will talk about the Bandicoot Superhighway on Tuesday October 25th starting at 7.30pm at the Hills Environment Centre, 4 Crescent Drive, Norton Summit.


